MAINTENANCE

STORM DOORS

There have been many service requests regarding storm door repairs. We want to take this time to explain some of the basics to all members.

When carrying in things like your groceries, members use the door cylinder to hold the door open. Remember that when you're done, release the closer and make sure the latch secures the storm door.

When a storm door is left open or the latch un-secured, you take the chance of the wind breaking the storm door.

Storm doors are part of the property that members take responsibility for and could be charged for repair or replacement.

DRAINS—Friendly reminders

Please advise household members and guest not to put anything down the drains or stools, except water, tissue and waste.

You should not pour grease down any drain, including the toilet. Pour into a container and throw in the trash.

Items like sanitary supplies or feminine hygiene products, paper towels, baby wipes and diapers should not be flushed.

Even items that say they are "Flushable", can cause an issue in the drains.

As a reminder, if maintenance or a plumber, has to pull a toilet to clear a clog, this could be chargeable to the member. If any of the above items are the reason for a clog, in any drain, members could be charged.



VALENTINES DAY

Did you know that the roots to the valentine holiday is from the ancient Roman festival of Lupercalia, a fertility celebration commemorated annually on February 15th.

Pope Gelasius recast this pagan festival as a Christian feast day circa 496, declaring February 14th to be St. Valentine's Day.

It was in the 14th century that this Christian feast day became definitively associated with Love. It was medieval scholar Henry Ansgar Kelly that first linked St. Valentine's day with love and romance.

WHAT IS PRESIDENT'S DAY

Presidents' Day, officially **Washington's Birthday**, is a holiday in the United States celebrated on the third Monday of February to honor all persons who served in the office of president in the United States. The federal holiday specifically honors George Washington and Abraham Lincoln

Washington's Birthday was celebrated on February 22 from 1879 until 1971, when the Uniform Monday Holiday Act moved it to the third Monday in February. The day eventually also became known as Presidents' Day and is most often an occasion to remember all U.S. presidents.
